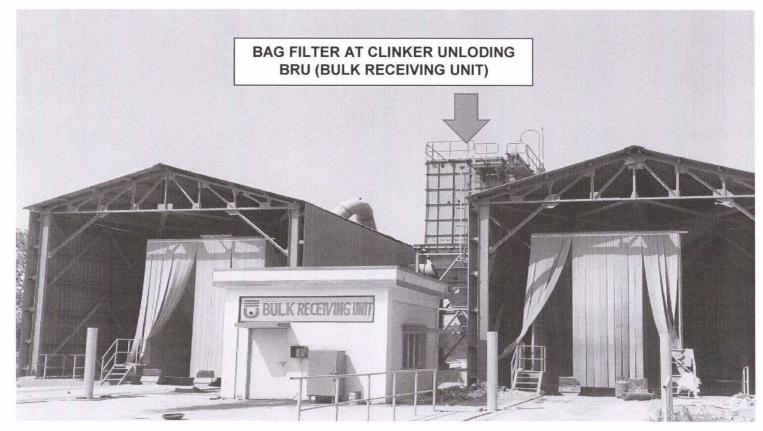

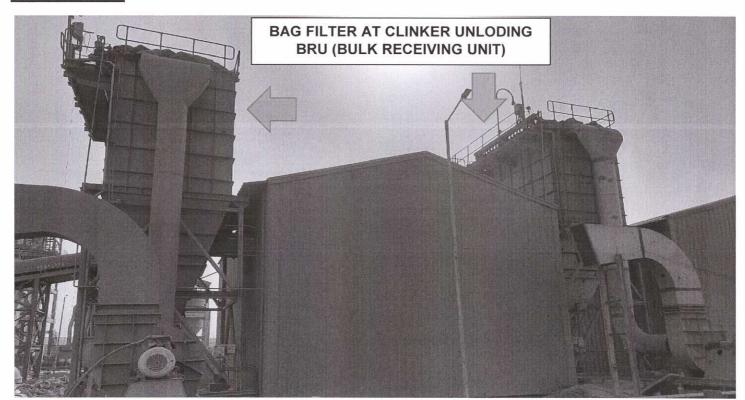

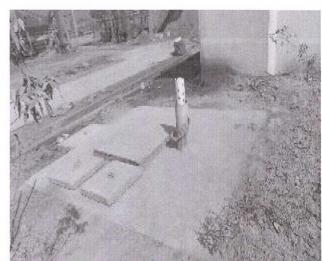


Rain Water Harvesting Pit No-2
