Kamla Nagar Township














LK Singhania Education Centre, Gotan

Project NIRMAAN



Project Nirmaan - the journey of 'One Group Transformation' was started with the objectives of:

- Operating as one group rather than collection of plants.
- Developing high performing business processes and technology capabilities.
- Bringing transparency in reporting.

We partnered with Accenture, a global consulting firm to develop best in class business processes and then engaged with multiple IT implementation partners for technology enablement of BPR recommendations through SAP upgrade and other add-on IT tools.

We are in the closure stage of Project Nirmaan and ensuring the adoption and sustenance of BPR recommendations has become even more essential to reap the benefits and achieve the project's objectives.

Progress during the period of July-August:

C4C-CRM Tool:

C4C is another step towards the transformation of Sales & Marketing function through effective and efficient customer relationship management. It is important to integrate the processes to give the stakeholders an efficient approach in maintaining and creating relationships with customers.

We had partnered with global consulting firm, PwC for C4C implementation which is scheduled to roll out in 2 phases – Wave 1 and Wave 2. Wave 1 functionalities (for both Grey & White Business) have gone live in the system with cumulative efforts of internal Coaches, PwC team and the entire JKC team.

Wave 1 C4C functionalities have been developed with continuous business inputs followed by rigorous validation and testing by designated Business Owners.

C4C will offer various benefits to the organization like:

- 1. On the go data access for decision making & planning
- 2. Content sharing
- 3. Managing sales data for strategic and tactical decision making
- 4. Reports & Dashboards for Analytics
- 5. Enhancing the stakeholders' experience
- Empowering sales team for better planning and execution
- 7. Standardization of reporting formats.

MDMS (Master Data Management Solution)

With an objective to streamline the Master Data Creation, Modification and Maintenance across the Company, MDMS Tool has been implemented for the following critical Masters being used in the organization:

NIRIMAAN

Materials Master, Equipment Master, Recipe (BOM) Master, Asset Master, GL Masters, Pricing Master, Vendor Master, Customer Master

Material Master, Equipment Master, Recipe (BOM) Master and Asset Master has been implemented across all Plants in India. The same is in progress for other Masters as well.

Some of the expected Business Benefits are:

- High quality master data creation by controlling duplicity (if any)
- 2. Accountability of creation
- 3. Verification and approval process
- 4. Reduced data entry through MDM rules engine
- 5. Defined workflows for approval processes
- 6. Quick master creation through standard procedure including system instead of mail trails
- 7. Audit Dashboard for transparency on Master data changes throughout the year

Management Reports:

Management Reports is one of the highly expected deliverables of Project Nirmaan which is essential to attain the objective of 'single source of truth' and 'transparency in reporting' across the organization. Reports have been developed and made available for the stakeholders in the areas of Procure to Pay (P2P), Plan to Produce (PLTP) and Order to Cash (O2C - White Business). Cost Sheet is also configured and available as an output from CO module in Record to Report (R2R).

followers.




Excel Training Program - Padam Tower, Delhi







Spotlight on Mr. SK Jain

(Excerpts from an interview with Mr. SK Jain - Head (Technical), Fujairah)

1) Please shed some light on your journey with the Company. What is the fondest memory of your association?

Lioined JK Cement as a Graduate Trainee Engineer on 13th Feb. 1983 and I have never looked back ever since. Since then, I have received excellent opportunities to grow professionally as well as personally. While heading the Mills Department, I carried out many critical modifications, especially mechanical optimization of the whole section and this proved to be a turning point of my life. In 1995, I got the chance to be a trainer at the Regional Training Centre, where I developed special training packages on alignment and hydraulics and conducted various training programs in India and abroad. Then, under the guidance of Mr D. Ravisankar, I got the opportunity to be part of the team responsible for setting up Mangrol line 1.

Year 2007 turned out to be a really crucial period for my career. I moved to Muddapur as General Manager (Projects) for Green field project and commissioned the plant in November 2009, which was a memorable moment for me. In 2012, I got promoted as the Head (Operations & Maintenance), a responsibility that came with many challenges and opportunities to grow. I took many initiatives to improve the work culture in the plant. In 2016, I got an opportunity to work in the project department handling all capex schemes. I am now a part of team at Fujairah and I am really grateful to our management for considering me for this new opportunity. I have countless memories, but one that I can still vividly recall is the time when I was working on spray lubrication system in cement mill No.3. I was so engrossed in my work that I didn't realise that a young, dynamic personality was observing me very keenly. It was only when he patted me on the back and encouraged me that I realised that it was our honourable Chairman & Managing Director, Mr Yadupati Singhania. His encouragement still inspires me to do better and achieve higher.

2) As the Head (Operations and Maintenance) of JK Cement Works, Muddapur, what are some of the challenges that you had to face? What initiatives did you undertake to strengthen the function?

During my tenure as the Head (O & M), I faced a number of challenges. The biggest challenge was to run the plant with minimum number of skilled manpower as skilled labour was not easily available. Nonetheless, we selected and trained (in house as well as on site) some ITI fitters, who are now an asset for the Company

Initially, after the first year of commissioning the vertical mill for cement grinding, we faced a lot of problems pertaining to mill vibrations, power

high and number of breakdowns. However, with our continuous efforts, we set everything in place and optimised the mill. In fact, the whole optimisation process was presented as a case study in one of the Pfeiffer International Seminars held in Jaipur. Apart from this, we also worked to bring down the plant power consumption from 90 units to average 78 units and



achieved sustainable cost cutting through implementation of 5 S approach under engineer's forum. One very significant challenge that we had to overcome happened when the clinker tank dome roof collapsed. However, with help of the entire team, the plant began operating within just 12 days, saving a lot of time and money. This entire operation was a historic moment in the Cement Industry.

Another unfortunate incident occurred when CF silo suddenly failed and had to somehow make it operable. The challenge was to take the minimum 250 T feed directly from raw mill to the kiln. Under the guidance of Mr. Madhavkrishna Singhania and joint efforts of the team, we successfully resumed the operation of the plant. Now the Cement Industry has accepted the idea of running a plant without CF silo or with minimum kiln feed storage capacity.

All these incidents and challenges never made me lose my confidence as I am a firm believer that challenges come to make us, not break us.

3) What have been some of your milestones/significant contributions during your tenure with the Company?

The first generation vertical mill from M/s FLS, Atox 42.5 was commissioned in 1987 at Nimbahera plant. Initially, the mill ran for only 4 hrs a day and the remaining 20hrs was for maintenance and modifications. We rigorously worked towards rectifying all the problems and optimised the mill. After 1991, the mill came to be known as one of the best vertical mills of M/s FLS in India. Another milestone was optimizing the raw mill (Atox 52.5) output at 610 TPH level with the power consumption of approximate 13 units in Muddapur Plant and also kiln output at 7000 TPD with the lowest manufacturing cost.

In Muddapur plant, we implemented 5S programme successfully and also designed, developed, fabricated and installed the complete plant for producing tile adhesive with the lowest cost. Under the leadership of Business Head, we implemented the Manufacturing Excellence drive 'Uddan', which was another significant milestone.






1. Go Green Rally - 11th August

to their children. Mr. Dileep Singh Krishnawat - DGM informed all present that the Company would provide solar lights and fans to all its adopted Anganwadis.






