An exciting new chapter in the AFR journey at Muddapur

A new milestone was achieved in the AFR (Alternate Fuel and Raw Material) journey with the inauguration of an all new 'AFR LABORATORY' at JK Cement Works, Muddapur. The laboratory was inaugurated by Mr. RBM Tripathi - Unit Head & Chief Guest in the presence of Mr. Umashankar Choudhary - Technical Head, Mr. Kapil Agrawal - Commercial Head and Mr. Shivayya B Swamy - HR Head along with other departmental heads, executives and contractual workmen.

AFR Lab encourages hands-on testing perspectives of AFR materials like Organic Matter, Minor Elements, Ultimate Analysis etc. Installation of major equipments will take place in a phase-wise manner in order to complete the AFR laboratory setup.







Understanding AFR

The Alternative Fuel and Raw Material strategy is used in the manufacturing of cement, which promotes recycling energy through waste, while using alternative raw materials ensures protection of non-renewable natural resources through material recycling.

We aim to reduce our dependency on natural resources and fossil fuels by converting alternative fuels and alternative raw materials into resources, for all our manufacturing processes. Meanwhile, we create social value by decreasing the need for municipal landfills and burning waste in incinerators, as well as by creating jobs for collecting and pre-processing waste.



A GreenCo initiative at Muddapur

Green Drive with a Battery Operated Electric Buggy

Being a GreenCo Gold rated plant, as a part of GreenCo initiative, JK Cement Works, Muddapur has implemented new ideas and schemes across the plant to reduce the scope of CO_2 emission. One such idea includes reducing the internal vehicle movement.










Training Programs at Regional Training Centre (RTC)


HR INITIATIVES
