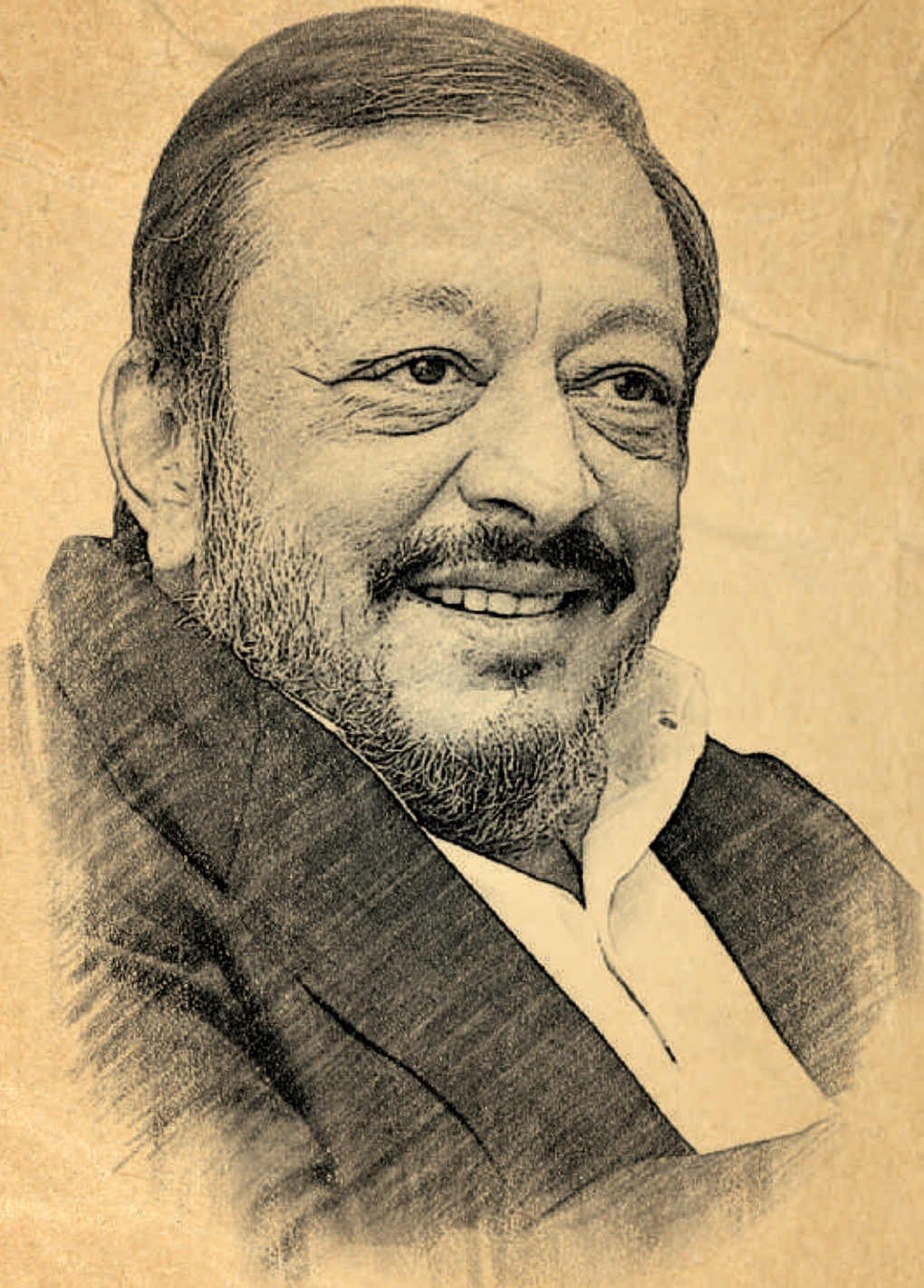

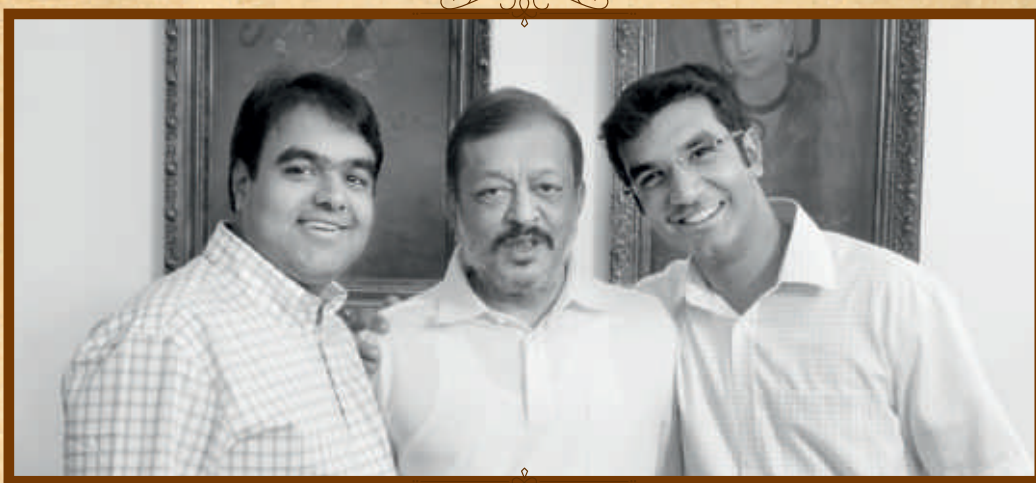

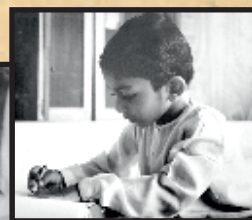

A favourite of his teachers at Methodist High School, Kanpur, he was an ace student and the ever curious child.

Benevolence and humanitarianism weaved into his moral fabric, the young lad showed keen intellect and insatiable desire to learn and as years passed by he led the way for millions as an industrialist, visionary and a nation builder.

THE TECHNOCRAT-ENTREPRENEUR

Mr. Yadupati Singhania earned his B.Tech degree in 1976 from the illustrious IIT Kanpur and joined the family business. Inspired by the family values, he knew that one must craft his own path to success and that no job is too small when it comes to learning and acquiring skills. He thus began his training, toiling on the shop floor under the watchful eyes of industry stalwarts Shri Sohanlal Singhaniaji, Sir Padampat Singhaniaji and father Dr. Gaur Hari Singhaniaji.

The cotton and cement divisions of JK Organisation marked the beginning of his career where he gained a 360 degrees perspective, working in technical, commercial and marketing aspects of business.

Mr. Singhania envisioned a growing Nation and acted as a catalyst with his responsible entrepreneurship that encompassed organizational growth which stimulated the Country's growth as well.

In his early years itself, he could sense the immense potential the cement industry held in our fast-growing economy. That meant establishing more cement plants to meet the increasing demand. A task easier said than done, also because the Singhania scion had exacting requirements. He visited several cement manufacturing units nationally and internationally and kept himself updated with the latest trends and technology to get first-hand information. He envisioned a world class plant, a wide range of superior building products and a global presence. But he wanted it sans exploitation of men, resources or environment. So, he not just built plants but a utopian world around it!

In over 40 years of service to the Nation, he built 8 cement plants across the Country at Nimbahera (Rajasthan), Mangrol (Rajasthan), Gotan (Rajasthan), Mudhol (Karnataka), Jhajjar (Haryana), Katni (Madhya Pradesh), Balasinor (Gujarat) and Aligarh (UP), generating several thousands of direct and indirect employment.



JK White Cement is a pioneering initiative of Mr. Singhania, being the first white cement facility in India, which was limestone based and manufactured white cement through the dry process. With this, JK Cement changed the landscape of India's cement industry. The White Cement plant at Gotan that came into being in 1984, inspired by his vision, magically transformed a barren, desolate small desert village into a thriving township, attracting other enterprising entrepreneurs and investors.

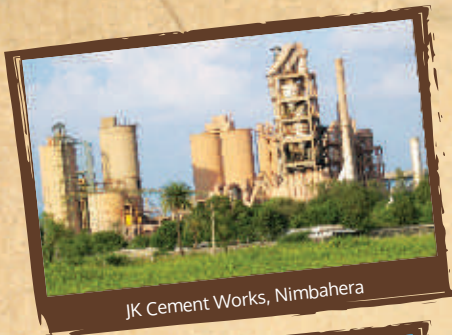
Going global and expanding beyond the Country's shores was Mr. Singhania's long-nurtured goal. He envisioned JK Cement leaving its gleaming mark on the international market and this dream was to see the beginnings of its realisation with the setting up of the maiden overseas plant at Fujairah, UAE. Today, the Company is the third largest white cement manufacturer in the world with exports to over 43 nations.

Under his leadership, JK Cement has recorded various accomplishments, positioning itself as a premier contributor in the Cement Industry. For over four decades, JK Cement has partnered India's multi-sectoral infrastructure needs on the strength of its product excellence, customer orientation and technology leadership.

The plants established by Mr. Singhania are industrial success stories today. This is a testament to his belief in sustainable growth and co-creating value for the Nation by investing in cutting-edge technology, highly skilled workforce and the environment.

It is so much easier to mourn in silence; it takes away the worry of not being able to get your words out.

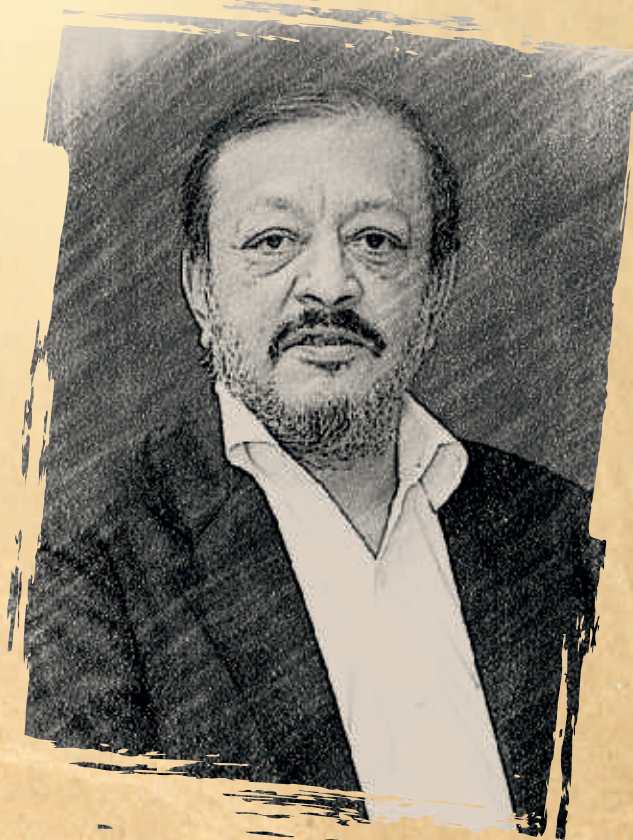
